NEPA Incorporation & Acquisition of a Yacht from Abroad



I. General Information on NEPA Companies

Pursuant to the modernized legal framework (Greek Law 4926/2022), NEPA (NEΠA – Nauτιλιακή Eταιρεία Πλοίων Ava ψ uχής) companies are the exclusive vehicle for the commercial operation of pleasure yachts under the Greek flag.

- Purpose: NEPA is a special-purpose Greek commercial company created exclusively to own, operate, or manage pleasure yachts flying the Greek flag as commercial vessels.
- **Founders:** A NEPA company may be established by one or more natural persons or legal entities. Non-EU/EEA nationals may participate without restrictions, unless otherwise limited by the Articles of Association.
- **Duration:** If not otherwise defined in the Articles of Association, the statutory company duration is thirty (30) years, with the possibility of renewal.
- **Registered Office:** The company's seat must be located in Greece.
- **Share Capital:** Minimum €10,000, fully paid in cash into the company's bank account within two months of incorporation. Shares are registered shares with a nominal value of at least €1.
- **Administration:** Managed by a Board of Directors consisting of at least three (3) members, appointed for a six-year term. Board members may be shareholders or not.
- **Tax Benefits:** NEPA companies benefit from significant exemptions, including no income tax on profits and various VAT exemptions.

II. Incorporation Procedure

- 1. Drafting the Articles of Association (simple private agreement; notarization is not required).
- 2. Obtaining a Greek Tax Identification Number (TIN) for the founders and members of the Board of Directors.
- 3. Submission and registration of the signed Articles with the **Registry of Pleasure Craft Maritime Companies** (under the Greek Ministry of Shipping & Island Policy).
- 4. Issuance of a unique registration number upon acceptance.



Following incorporation, the company may open a corporate bank account in Greece or another EU country to manage charter income and operating expenses.

III. Yacht Transfer

- Deregistration from the Foreign Registry.
- Transfer of ownership to the NEPA company.
- Registration under the Greek flag at the Hellenic Ministry of Shipping.

IV. Yacht Charter Licensing & Operations

- Submission of all required documents to obtain the professional charter license (Commercial Vessel Permit).
- Mandatory insurance coverage of the vessel.

V. Timeline

- NEPA incorporation & tax registrations: approx. **2–3 weeks** (depending on document availability and tax office processing).
- Yacht deregistration & transfer: approx. **4–6 weeks** (depending on foreign registry and Greek authorities).
- **Overall duration:** We recommend planning a total timeframe of **6–8** weeks.
